Coal workers share Christmas cheer with children in need

Premier Coal workers are helping put a smile on the face of children living in disadvantage this Christmas.

Workers at the Collie coal mine are supporting The Smith Family's Toy and Book Appeal, which aims to deliver more than 45,000 new toys and 30,000 new books to children in need around Australia.
